

ISMs Explained: The first 4 are all forms of **Collectivism**

where the rights of the group are considered to outweigh the rights of the individual.

Socialism: You have two cows. The Gov't forces you to give one to your neighbor.

Communism: You have two cows. Gov't takes them, they may give you some milk back.

Fascism: You have two cows. Government takes the milk, sells it, & keeps the money.

Nazism: You have two cows. The government shoots you and takes both cows.

Anarchism: You have two cows. You keep both cows, beat up the gov't agent that tries to take or tax you or your cows. You take another cow from Gov't for your trouble.

Most people erroneously believe we operates under capitalism, we don't.

Capitalism: You have two cows. You sell one and buy a bull.

In reality, we operate under Monopoly Capitalism.

Monopoly Capitalism: You have two cows. Laws are made that create barriers & unnecessary expenses. This makes it impractical to own cows &/or sell the milk. This leads you to sell your cows (cheap) to BIG Dairy. Big Dairy bought and paid for the legislators to pass the laws in the first place.

Voluntaryism: You have two cows. You voluntarily choose to discount or give away some of the milk produced to help those in need.

Constitutional Republic (what we are meant to be) vs. Democracy (most think we are)

A Constitutional Republic: The constitution spells out the basic rules for gov't to follow while protecting the people from overreach. Elected 'representatives' carry out the services delegated by the people to gov't. It is supposed to be of, by, & for the people.

A Democracy is basically Mob Rule. 50.1% of the population can force the other 49.9 % to do whatever the majority decides. You have 2 cows. The mob votes to take them.
